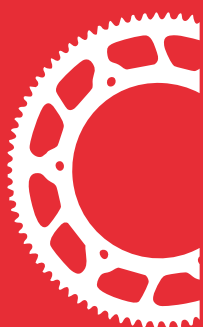

FEATURES IN THE REGULATIONS



MINI MAX / MICRO MAX

GEAR RATIO / SPROCKET

- **Imposed for MICRO MAX :**
Engine Sprocket 15 teeth / Rear Sprocket 70 teeth (+/- 1 teeth)
- **Imposed for MINI MAX :**
Engine Sprocket 14 teeth / Rear Sprocket 68 teeth (+/- 1 teeth)



EXHAUST IN PARC FERMÉ MICRO / MINI ONLY

As part of our ongoing efforts to ensure fair competition and enhance anti-cheating measures, we are introducing a sealed area (parc fermé) dedicated to exhaust systems for MICRO MAX and MINI MAX categories.

All exhausts will be inspected, sealed, and stored in this secure area before and after each session.

FOR ALL CATEGORIES

CIK-FIA EQUIPMENT

From now on, CIK-FIA approved GLOVES AND SHOES are mandatory for all drivers.

They are added to the already required equipment:

- CIK-FIA approved SUIT
- CIK-FIA approved HELMET
- CIK-FIA approved RIB PROTECTORS
- NECK SUPPORT (mandatory in Mini Max and Micro Max).
- **CIK-FIA approved GLOVES**
- **CIK-FIA approved SHOES**

RACE NUMBERS AND STICKERS

- 1.** The race numbers on a yellow background must be stuck on the nassau-panel, the pontoons and the rear burmper. The race numbers may not be cut out.
- 2.** The sticker of your category must be stuck under the race number of the nassau-panel.
- 3.** A RMCIT sticker must be stuck to the nassau-panel.

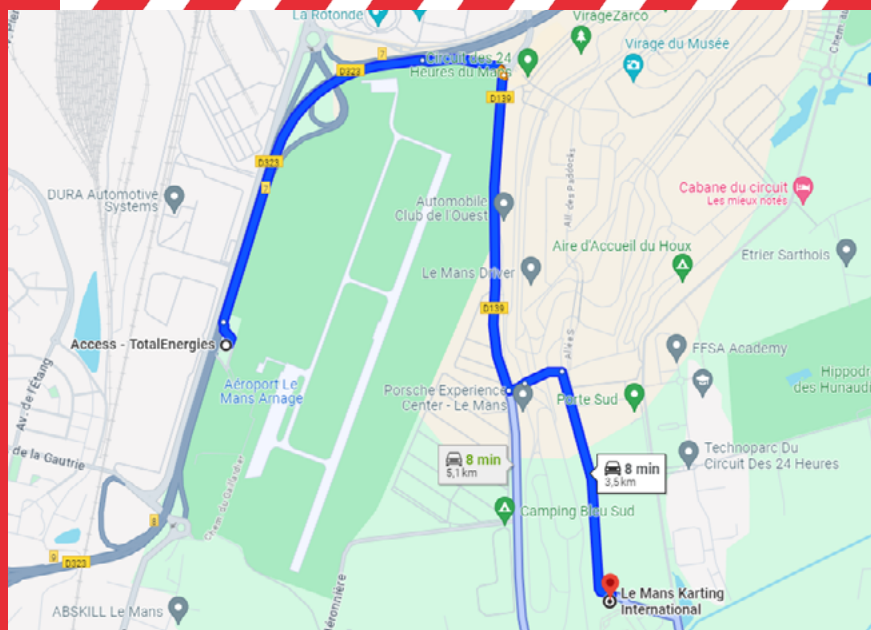

CODE OF GOOD CONDUCT

- 1.** Drivers must respect the rules, officials and their decisions.
- 2.** Participants shall respect and show dignity to differences in gender, ability, physical appearance, culture and religion.
- 3.** Participants are responsible for their actions in all circumstances.
- 4.** Participants must ensure that their equipment is in conformity. Equipment must be approved.

A participant must be able to assess his or her level and abilities in relation to the other participants.
- 5.** They must also be able to assess the risks associated with training and racing. A minimum level is required.
- 6.** Participants must be courteous. Problems of cohabitation between participants must be dealt with respect, without insults or invectives.
- 7.** The safety of children is a priority. Ethics must be encouraged. It is the responsibility of the participants to ensure the safety of the children in all circumstances.
- 8.** During a race, it is the responsibility of the drivers to read and understand the rules, announcements and schedules. All questions must be asked at the 3MK Events area.
- 9.** Participants must respect the environment. Participants must limit excessive noise (engines...) and use the places defined to reduce noise and pollution.
- 10.** The use of appliances with high electrical consumption (heating, tumble dryers, air conditioners, etc.) is forbidden in the paddock.
- 11.** Alcohol and drugs (cannabis or others...) are strictly forbidden during training sessions or races.
- 12.** All abusive comments on social networks (Twitter, Facebook...) towards teams, participants, organisers or any other person associated with the RMCIT universe may be sanctioned.



ANY BREACH OF THESE RULES WILL BE STRONGLY SANCTIONED. DISCIPLINARY ACTION WILL BE TAKEN AGAINST ANY OFFENDER.



DRIVERS RULES REMINDER



**ALWAYS KEEP IN MIND:
OFFICIALS ARE VOLUNTEER KARTING ENTHUSIAST.**

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Reminder of important points (not exhaustive) :

- The driver's clothing must comply with the regulations.
- The driver is responsible for his equipment and transponder.
- The equipment must comply with the registration sheet.
- Assistance is not allowed on the circuit. The pick-up vehicle will be used from the time trials.
- Respect the yellow flag.
- When you enter the closed finish area of the repair area, raise your arm.
- When you leave the repair area, you do not have priority.
- On-board camera prohibited from time trials (prohibited on the helmet during free practice).
- The use of drone is forbidden.
- Floating object on the driver = immediate stop.
- Pay attention to the direction of rotation and the tightening of the wheels.

PRE-GRID & PARC FERMÉ:

- Respect the volunteers in the start and finish parc fermé.
- In the start-finish parc fermé, only the driver (wearing his category wristband) and his mechanic (wearing his badge) are authorized.
- The pre-grid closes 5 minutes before the start (sound signal).



THE FLAGS



Slow down, start of neutralized zone, serious danger, no overkating, raise your hand above your helmet and be ready to stop.



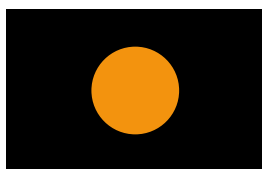
Signal to stop a race, slow down, stop overtaking, drive at reduced speed, stop at the point indicated by the Race Director at the briefing.



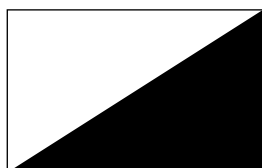
End of neutralized zone



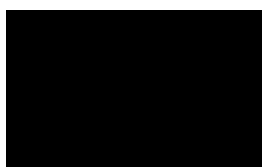
Stand still : keep your line, you'll be overtaken by one or more drivers. Restless : Give away.

Stop for technical or clothing defect

TYRES PROCEDURE



MONDAY AFTERNOON & TUESDAY:

UNOFFICIAL «FREE PRACTICE» TYRES

Any driver who has not reserved an extra set of tyres at the time of registration will be able to buy a set of tyres at the tyres truck, depending on the quantities remaining.



WEDNESDAY:

«OFFICIAL FREE PRACTICE» SET OF TYRES

Collect your «official free practice» tyres and have them flashed at the tyres truck on Tuesday before 6:30 pm. Only these tires will be authorized for Wednesday's official free practice and warm-up sessions. Furthermore, in the event of a puncture on the «Race» tyres, the driver will be authorized to use a tyre from the «Official Free Practice» on Friday, subject to the agreement of the FFSA technical delegate.



FROM QUALIFYING EXPECT WARM UP:

RACE TYRES

Go to the parc fermé for the distribution of race tyres during the period indicated on the meeting schedule. These tyres will not be stored in the parc fermé. Only these tyres will be authorized for qualifying and races.



RAIN RACE TYRES

Rain Race tyres must be purchased during the period indicated on the meeting schedule.

Go to the parc fermé at the tyre distribution point during the period indicated on the meeting schedule to collect them. These «Rain Race» tyres will not be stored in the parc fermé. Only these «Rain Race» tyres will be authorized for qualifying and races.

SATURDAY WARM UP:

During the warm-up, the official free practice tyres must be used.»



SATURDAY FINAL:

ONLY MAX SENIOR QUALIFIED FOR FINAL

Go to Parc Fermé for the distribution during the period indicated on the meeting schedule and with your Mechanic Pass. **Only these tyres will be authorized for MAX Senior FINAL.**



USED TYRES: BINS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE TRAILER.



SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENT

Reminder of the FFSA 2026 Sporting annex regulations : safety environment

- Each driver in the paddock must be equipped with a fire extinguisher with a minimum capacity of 6 kg and designed to fight a hydrocarbon fire (valid extinguisher).
- The fire extinguisher must be presented before entering the paddock and must be placed under the canopy of the structure in a visible and accessible place.
- Drivers must use a **protective ground sheet with an absorbent mat**, with a minimum size of 1.50 m x 1.90 m to avoid hydrocarbon stains during competitions or training sessions.
- We ask you to keep your pitch clean. Garbage bags are at your disposal.



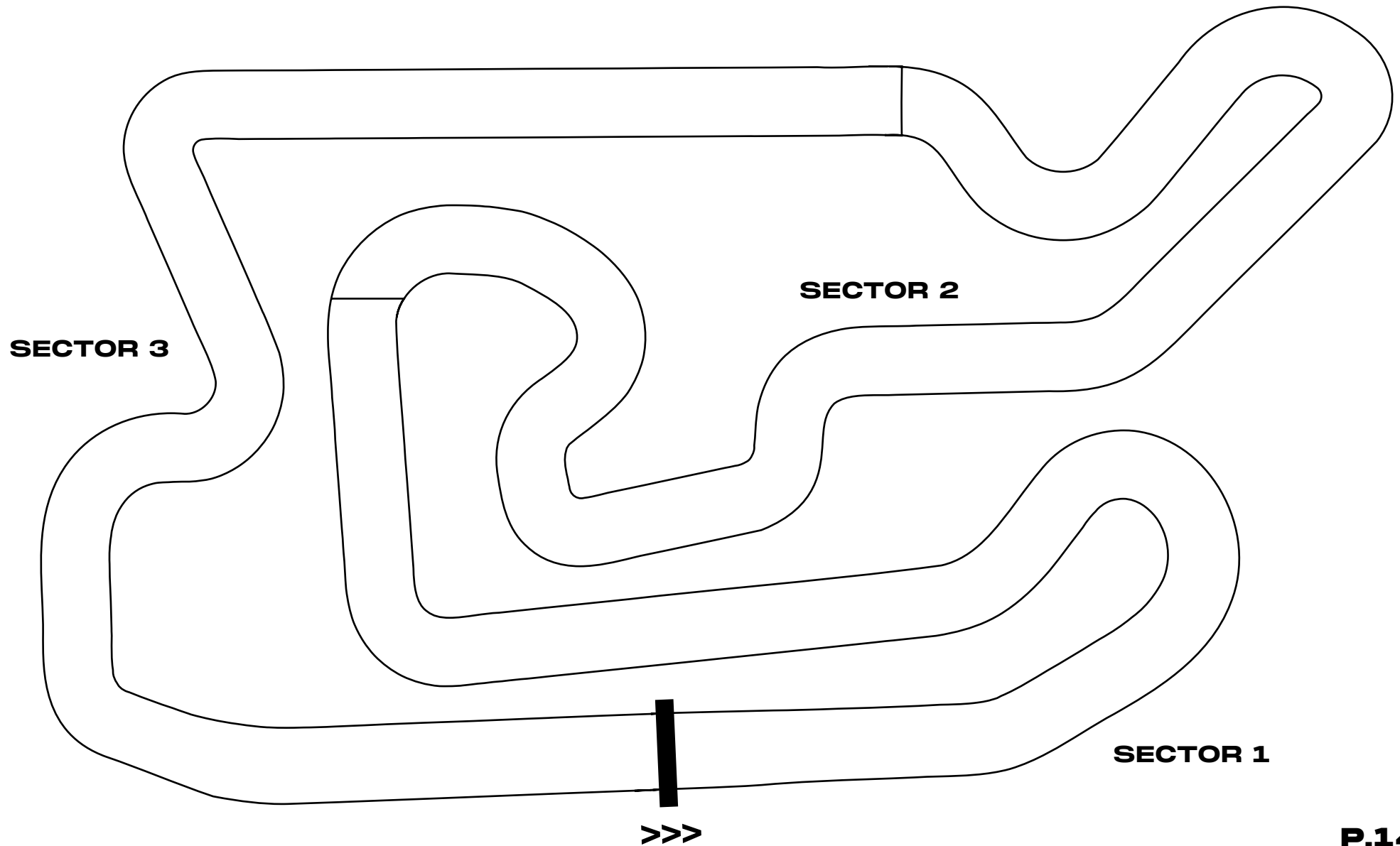

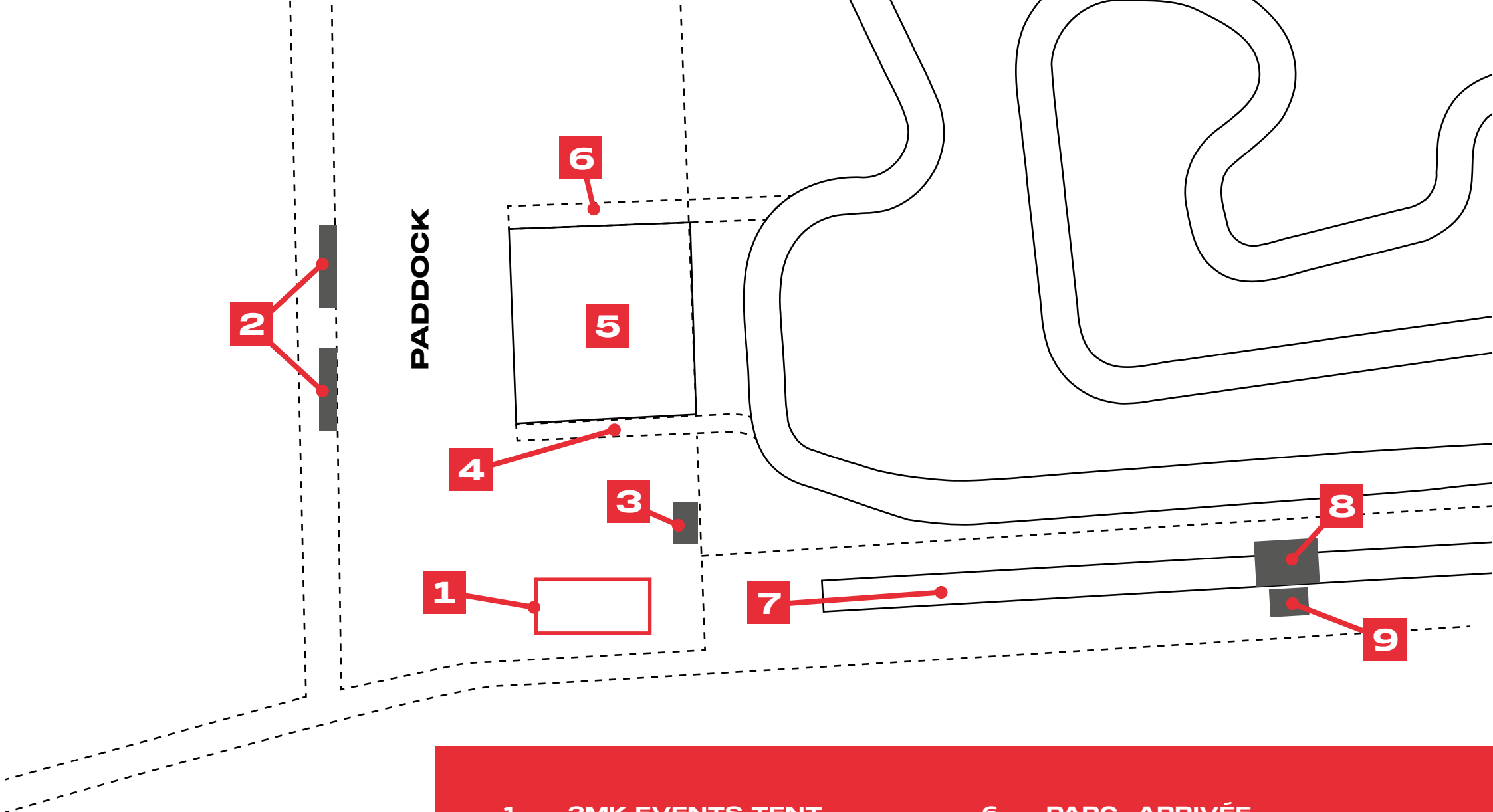
Reminder of the FFSA 2026 Sporting annex regulations : safety environment

- Starting, running in, warming up or testing kart engines in the paddock as well as in the reserved areas (see Art. 20 of the International Sporting Code) is strictly prohibited.
- Offenders will be fined a minimum of €250. In case of repeated infringements, the Stewards may disqualify the Driver concerned from the Competition.

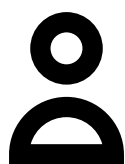
